Trash and Recycling Rules

Adopted March 13, 2018

General Information

Trash & debris in the Cluster can be unsightly, reduce property values, and create unsanitary conditions. It is important that we reduce the chance of litter throughout the neighborhood.

Residents should who do not use trash cans should place trash in sturdy, well tied plastic. Lightweight plastic bags, or those not properly secured, are highly susceptible to tearing by wildlife.

Schedule for Placement and Pickup

- Trash is collected Monday and Thursday; Recycling is only collected on Thursday.
- Trash & recycling can be placed at the curb only after sundown the night before pickup.
- Trash & recycling must be stored in cans or bins, or in heavy duty securely tied bags.
- Empty cans and bins must be removed from common ground property by sunrise the day after pickup and stored per the guidelines below.

Please do not place trash and recycling behind parked cars where it may be missed.

Storage of Trash and Recycling

Trash cans, recycling bins, and trash bags may not be stored in the front or side of homes unless behind an approved fence. These items cannot be viewable from the common ground along the street.

Yard Waste

Yard waste is collected on Wednesday. Yard waste should be placed in paper biodegradable or clear plastic bags available from most home improvement stores. Branches should be cut into no more than 4' length and tied in bundles.

Items Requiring Special Pickup

Residents may not place appliances, furniture, building materials, brick and block, or other non-household trash at the curb for regular pickup. These items require a special bulk pickup and residents are responsible for arranging pickup and paying any associated fees.

Do not place wet paint or stains at the curb! Dry paint in the can and mix with cat litter. When completely hardened, place at curb.
